- *(Proof of Residency includes Rental/Lease agreement, home purchase documents, or electricity bill and must include parent/guardian name(s) and verify current address.)
- 9) Additionally, please provide a copy of your student's complete transcript from previous middle/junior (incoming 9th grader) or high school(s) (incoming 10-12th grader)
- 10) Contact assigned counselor to make appointment to discuss student's schedule

The students entire family unit has had a change of residence (physical relocation) into the boundaries of this school and has vacated occupancy of their previous residence. Residence is defined as the place where the family has established its home and/or the place where the student is habitually present and to which, when departing, the student intends to return. • Family unit is defined as the adult(s) who the student has resided with, and acted in a parental capacity of the student and siblings for a period of at least 1 year. If the answer is yes to question 3 student is most likely eligible with residency. Please connect family with Athletic
